# Little Roman's parents refused to give up

**A MOTHER is celebrating after the birth of her fifth child – despite being sterilised.**

Jenni Jones, from Horsneile Lane, Bracknell, was sterilised after the birth of her fourth child, Devon.

However, she could not help feeling that her and her husband Jack were missing something.

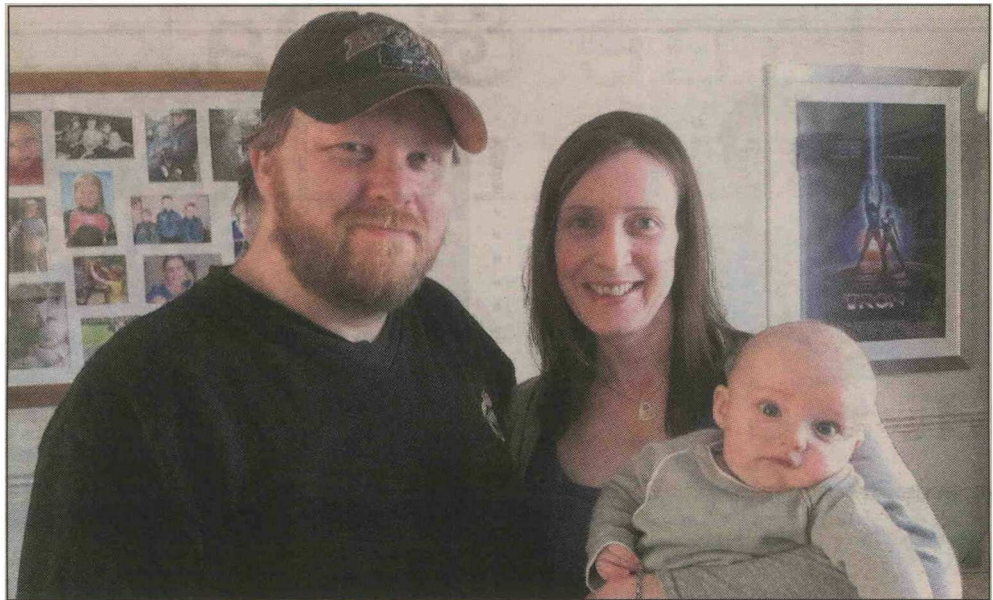
Despite finances and 'common sense' telling her four children were more than enough, she investigated if it was possible to reverse the sterilisation.

Consultant gynaecologist Clive Pickles, from BMI Park Hospital in Nottingham, made their fifth child, Roman, a reality.

Mrs Jones said: "I had paid to see a consultant who told me that, seeing as I had been sterilised at the same time as a c-section, a reversal would not be successful.

"That left IVF as our only route.

"We paid for two cycles but both failed and, with finances at rock bottom and me approaching 40, we were almost ready to give up.

"In a last-ditch attempt to find a solution I scoured the internet and found Mr Pickles.

"Just one week after my last IVF had failed I telephoned him and, within minutes, he had put all my fears to rest."

With more than 20 years'

experience, Mr Pickles performed the operation in 2012, baby Roman was born, in December last year.

Mr Pickles explained: "When the tubes have been cut and tied after a Caesarean section the success of reversal surgery depends on a few factors,

the main one being the amount of tube that is left.

"In Jenni's case there was definitely enough to work with."

Mrs Jones added: "It has been a long hard road, both emotionally and financially, but we would do it all again in a heartbeat."
